

# Read Me First!

Please read before installing RM Math Framework Edition at your school.

Thank you for purchasing RM Math Framework Edition. It is recommended that you install your software a couple of weeks prior to training to make sure everything is up and running smoothly. It is important that the educational consultants make the training a hands on experience. This means that each teacher should have their own pc's to follow along during the training. Here are some helpful tips below:

There are a couple of different options to setup your software. It can be used as a Mobile Clients or Client/Server. In a client server type setup all of the content is stored on the server. In a mobile client setup it is stored locally on the teacher's machine. Even though the installations are different the software essentially works the same way from an end user perspective. The program uses your available internet connection to synchronize with the RM Database (this is discussed in detail in the RMMFE Installation and User Guide).

It is recommended that you use a mobile client setup if you have a Novell server (the Kaleidos application is SQL based which requires a windows platform). It is also recommended that you use a mobile client if you have a low end server that is primarily used for file and print sharing. You would also want to consider the mobile client installation on laptops that are being used in the school but will also be taken home by teachers. With this type of installation they will be able to work with Kaleidos at home as well.

Before installation please disable any anti-virus program that is running in the background because it can sometimes interfere with the installation of Kaleidos.

Where does Kaleidos get installed?

Only the Math teacher's machines need the Kaleidos application installed. This includes the 6, 7 and 8th grade content, which is imported from within Kaleidos. They also need Easiteach, GSP, QuickTime and Shockwave. These are the underlying applications that are needed to use the resources within the software.

In the student labs the computers would only need the underlying applications loaded (GSP, Easiteach, QuickTime and shockwave). There is no need to have Kaleidos loaded on these computers. Students will only need to access the [www.mywork.rm.com](http://www.mywork.rm.com) website to gather assignments, homework, tests, etc.
